



### WHY LEARN AMHARIC?

The Amharic (አማርኛ Amarigna) script is the only pure literature of the African in Africa. As a matter of fact, it is one of the main evidences to support the claim that ETHIOPIA has been the fountain of civilization in Africa. There is no reason why the ETHIOPIAN language can not be taught to every Black person in the world for a wealth of historical material of Black man is found only in this language.

The Amharic alphabet (Feedel ፊደል) has, so far, been used only in ETHIOPIA; but there are many languages within ETHIOPIA that use the alphabet. The origin of the Feedel ፊደል, however, still remains obscure and requires further research. Gi'iz g[z, one of the Ancient languages that uses the Feedel ፊደል, is now classically antiquated, and other ETHIOPIAN languages that had previously not used the Feedel ፊደል are now using it. The Feedel ፊደል itself has changed only slightly, just enough to accommodate the additional sounds for the different languages. The ETHIOPIAN alphabet (Feedel ፊደል) has been able to do this because of the simplicity of its nature; it is a phonetic alphabet.

We have in the Amharic alphabet (Feedel ፊደል) every conceivable sound in any language. Therefore, the persons who have learned how to pronounce the Amharic letters will have acquired a power in the lingual and labial production of words in any language, thus making it easy for the process of learning other languages.

Those who wish to learn the language should try to learn to write and recognize these characters by continuous practice. After these characters are learned, a great part of the language is accomplished.

**The Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated,** is a not-for-profit membership organization, incorporated on August 25, 1937 in the State of New York, United States of America and registered by the Internal Revenue Services as a 501 (C) 4 (civic- league, social welfare) tax exempt corporation and with the Ethiopian Civil and Local authorities, the African Union, as well as the UNO. The E.W.F., Inc., came into being originally because of Italy's blatant act of aggression (attack) against Ethiopia in October of 1935.

**EWf PREAMBLE**

We, the Black Peoples of the World, in order to effect Unity, Solidarity, Liberty, Freedom and Self-determination, to secure Justice and maintain the Integrity of Ethiopia, which is **our divine heritage**, do hereby establish and ordain this Constitution for the Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated.

**ARTICLE I (In brief)**

**NAMES, AIMS AND OBJECTS**

**Section 1.** The name of this organization shall be the Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated.

**Sec. 2.** The aims and objects of the Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, shall be:

**(a). To promote love and good-will among Ethiopians at home and abroad** and thereby to maintain the integrity and sovereignty of Ethiopia, to disseminate the ancient Ethiopian culture among its members, to correct abuses, relieve oppression and carve for ourselves and our posterity, a destiny comparable with our idea of perfect manhood and God's purpose in creating us; that we may not only save ourselves from annihilation, but carve for ourselves a place in the Sun: in this endeavor, we determine to seek peace and pursue it (Psalm 34:14), for it is the will of God for man.

**ARTICLE II—MEMBERSHIP**

**Section 1.** The membership shall comprise the BLACK PEOPLES of the world (Matthew 10:6).

**Sec. 2. APPLICATION:** Application for membership shall be in writing.

**Sec. 3. Rejection.** The Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, shall have the right to reject any application for membership without giving reasons.

**Sec. 4. Joining fee.** The Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, shall have the right to a fix a joining fee. There shall be a joining fee of One Dollar (U.S. \$ 1.00). However, The Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, through its Executive Council, shall have the right to grant special dispensation to certain areas and to adjust this fee to suit the conditions thereof, provided, however, that in no area the amount effected by the dispensation shall exceed One Dollar (U.S. \$1.00).

**Sec. 5. Dues:** The Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, shall have the right to establish membership dues. The membership dues shall be ten cents (U.S. \$.10) per week. These dues shall be remitted to the Headquarters. *(Membership are encouraged to give according to today's 'dollar value'. For example, \$1 then, \$10 now and \$0.10 then, at least \$1.00 now.—Transitional Exec. Cmte.)*

**Sec. 6. Unfinancial Members:** Any member who is twelve weeks in arrears in the payment of dues shall be unfinancial in the organization.



**ARTICLE VI**

**ESTABLISHMENT OF LOCALS**

**Section 1. (a).** Any twenty-five (25) persons or more, desirous of forming a local, shall apply to the Executive Council for a charter.

(b). The fee for this charter shall be Ten (\$10.00) Dollars. *(Same note applies as ART. 2 SEC. 5)*

**Sec. 2.** The officers of each local of the Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, shall be: *President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, Financial Secretary, Recording-Corresponding Secretary, Chaplain, Sergeant-at-Arms.*

**Sec. 3.** Each local shall establish an Executive Committee. This Executive Committee shall be composed of *the President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Treasurer, Financial Secretary, Recording-Corresponding Secretary, Chaplain, Sergeant-at-Arms and the three (3) other members elected by the local.*

**ARTICLE XI**

**OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL HOLIDAYS**

**Section 1. Observance of National Holidays:** The Ethiopian World Federation, Incorporated, shall observe with appropriate ceremonies the following holidays: መስቀል Meskel, የቀዳማዊ ኃይለ ሥላሴ ልደት ቀን Qedamawee Hayle Silassae's Birth Day, Constitution Day, and any other HolyDay that shall be declared.

**\*Preparations during Iyobelu—Jubilee for the Ethiopian Millennium 2007, Holy Sukkot (Tabernacles—Zech. 14:16), and International and Special Conventions are TBA as Legal & Constitutional order is restored and renewed in accordance with our Divine Heritage (Isaiah 58:12; Amos 9:11)**
